

Southern Baptist Schools Train Ministers

Of Southern Baptist pastors who have attended college, 83 per cent attended a Southern Baptist college, 9 per cent some other church college, 17 per cent a private college, and 22 per cent a state college, according to a survey conducted jointly by the office of the Southern Baptist Education Commission and the Department of Survey and Statistics of the Sunday School Board. These results were obtained by sending questionnaires to about two thousand Southern Baptist pastors.

Of those who have attended a seminary, 87 per cent attended a Southern Baptist seminary, 7 per cent a Northern Baptist seminary, and 10 per cent some other seminary. Because some attended more than one college or seminary, the totals of the percentages above exceed 100 per cent.
