### FROM OUR PASTOR . . . . .

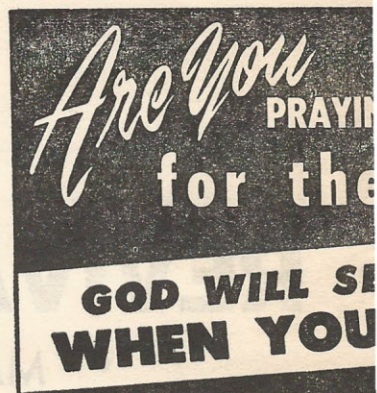
The following letter was received from Dr. Bennett:

My dear Friends:

One of God's imperative commands is, "Go Forward." Every report that reaches me from your great church is added evidence that you take His command seriously. For in every phase of kingdom activity, you are on the move—marching forward.

visitation; (3) Attend with regularity the public services held daily; (4) Appeal to the lost and unenlisted through Gospel singing and preaching.

As the Apostle wrote to the Christians at Rome, so I write to you: "I thank my God through Jesus Christ for you all . . . I make mention of you always in my prayers . . . For I long to see you . . . that I may be comforted together with you by the mutual faith . . . As much as in me is, I am ready to preach the Gospel to you that are at Pensacola also. For I am not ashamed of the Gospel of Christ for it is the power of God unto salvation to everyone that believeth."
