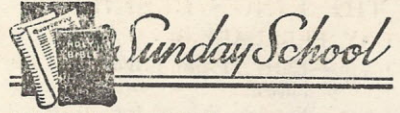
We are looking forward to a period of great growth, climaxing with our revival effort, March 6-13. The Lord is blessing our work, and His cause is growing every day.

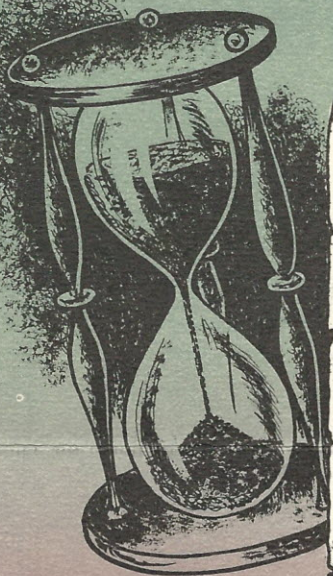
