

The Annie Armstrong Offering to date has amounted to \$1398.88, with a goal of \$1500.00.

Our Youth Week Officers have been doing an excellent job. Mr. Bizzell pointed out to the Deacons Monday night that only six out of 54 failed to assume their Training Union responsibilities last Sunday night and they were accounted for. This is a far better record than our Adults often make.

Visitors were present last Sunday from 17 states and Canada. Exactly 151 filled out Visitor's Cards. An even 100 of these were from out of town. Eight service men were present. Twelve were members of other local churches, while 31 are possible prospects for membership here. There were 36 at the 8:30 service, 107 at the 11:00 a.m., and 7 at 7:30 p.m.

Our Treasurer reported to the Deacons that for the first quarter of the year our actual Budget gifts were \$10,669.00 less than the \$56,250.00 which was the proposed budget for the quarter. The budget gifts were \$3,584.61 more than for the same period last year, and our Building Fund designations for the quarter were \$2,375.29. This is considerably less than the \$20,109.36 designated for the building and the \$2,428.20 designated for the organ during the first quarter last year. Of course, we must bear in mind that our emphasis has been on Budget gifts this year and we had a Special Building Fund drive last year. I thought that you'd like to see this end of the first quarter picture.
