

MAKING LIFE WORTHWHILE

Dr. W. H. Baylor, a retired minister of Baltimore, recently celebrated his 95th birthday. On this occasion, he wrote



a little article entitled "Making Life Worthwhile at 95." I would like to share a portion of this article with you.

1) Keep in mind that God always gives the best and forgives the worst. He is the giving and forgiving One. 2) Look for the best in people — for there is always some good in the worst. 3) Cheerful yesterday and hopeful tomorrows will keep us joyful today. 4) Resolve that whatever the provocation we will not lose our temper for when we do, we usually lose our cause. 5) Have no animosities and hold no grudges; these are like cancer eating away our life. 6) Keep in contact with your friends, for by neglecting them you might lose them. Try hard never to lose a friend nor make an enemy. 7) Do not confine your reading to subjects relating to your special work. Books and magazines on subjects entirely different are most helpful. 8) Shadows mean light somewhere. When disappointment and sorrow come, remember that Christ is the Light of the World bringing sunshine and solace. 9) Many Christians fear death though it is a heritage of the believer. Paul says, "All things are yours whether life or death. What glorious things await us." I Corinthians 2:9.

Let's not wait until we are 95 to think these thoughts. Let's start them today, then enjoy being 95.
