SNOW FALLS IN PENSACOLA — AND JERUSALEM

So help me I saw it with my own eyes. It wasn't exactly a blizzard. There were no traffic jams. You couldn't track rabbits in it. The airport didn't close, nor did anyone make snow ice cream—



but it snowed nevertheless. It happened early last Sunday morning right here in Pensacola, FLORIDA. (At least one other member of the church saw it — I am glad he did!)

To me there is something absolutely fascinating about snow-

fall. They say as you grow older it loses its fascination. Don't you believe it.

Snow in Pensacola is an oddity, nor does it snow very much in Jerusalem. However, on rare occasions it still snows here—and there. They had a 12-inch snow in Jerusalem this past week.

I don't know that it happened this way. I wasn't there, but I have a feeling that one day about 2700 years ago Isaiah watched it snowing in the sacred city and then penned the words found in the first chapter of his prophecy. Listen. "Come now, and let us reason together, saith the Lord: though your sins be as scarlet, they shall be as white as snow; though they be red like crimson, they shall be as wool."

What a beautiful picture of God's promise to forgive.
