

MADRID CALLING

Several months ago, many of you brought clothing here to the church to be sent to Madrid. The response was truly outstanding. This letter arrived from the Charles Whitens yesterday.



"Dear Pastor and Friends:

"We want to inform you that the past month has been a time of receiving packages from you. These thirty large boxes of used clothing have come through in good condition and have been received with great rejoicing and thanksgiving.

"It seems that the coldest part of Madrid's winter has been held over until March, so it would be impossible for you to fully realize how great has been the need of these people who have had no experience with cold weather.

"A good number of Cuban children are arriving in Spain, unaccompanied, and they have so little clothing with them. With all our hearts we want to thank you and everybody who may have had part in this effort to help provide for the needs of these refugees.

"We will be going on furlough in August of this year, and during the year that we are in the States, we trust that we will have the opportunity to thank you in person.
