

Our Revival preacher will be Dr. Robert Ernest Naylor, President of Southwestern Baptist Theological Seminary, Fort Worth, Texas. Dr. Naylor is a graduate of East Central State Teacher's College, Ada, Oklahoma and of Southwestern Baptist Theological Seminary, Fort Worth, Texas.

Before assuming the presidency of Southwestern in 1958, Dr. Naylor had served as pastor in Nashville, Arkansas; Malvern, Arkansas; Enid, Oklahoma; Columbia, South Carolina; and Travis Avenue Baptist, Fort Worth, Texas.

Dr. Naylor has traveled in Europe, the Near East, South America, Africa, the Orient, and in Australia.

He is called upon frequently as the preacher for State Assemblies, Evangelistic Conferences, and State Conventions.


If you care, you'll be much in prayer about our revival effort. Dr. Naylor will be here Sunday. Let's go all out during these crucial days.

When children and youth are not conquered by Christ, they will be conquered by other gods, and miss the purpose of God for their life.

How You Forgive — HAVE A BIG HEART.


"If you forgive not men their trespasses, neither will your Father forgive your trespasses." Matthew 6:15.
