MRS. NORMAN VINCENT PEALE



Mrs. Norman Vincent Peale, Co-Editor of Guideposts magazine, will be a special guest at the Award Service on Monday, January 19.

Our church has been chosen to receive the 1970 Guideposts Church Award. Each year since 1958, Guideposts, a religious magazine read by an estimated 6 million persons each month, has surveyed the program of churches and synagogues throughout America in search of outstanding initiative and spiritual creativity by congregation and pastor, priest, or rabbi. It is because of initiative and creativity that First Baptist is being honored as Church of the Year.

Dr. Norman Vincent Peale, editor-in-chief of Guideposts, will present the Award in a special service in our Sanctuary on Monday, January 19, at 7:30 p.m.

Probably no minister of our time has a more far-flung pulpit than Dr. Peale. Through his books, radio and television programs, and speeches, he has and is reaching millions of people throughout the world.

From his pulpit at Marble Collegiate Church in New York City, Dr. Peale preaches to some 4,000 people every Sunday. His sermons are broadcast and later published by the Foundation for Christian Living and mailed to 500,000 persons each month. His largest "congregation," however, is made up of the readers of his 16 published books, one of which—The Power of Positive Thinking—has been translated into 30 languages and has sold over 2½ million copies.

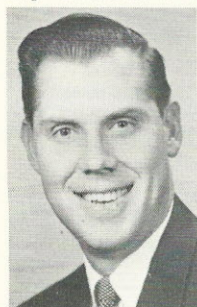
Dr. Peale will be the featured speaker at the special Award Service. Every member of our church should plan to attend and bring his friends.

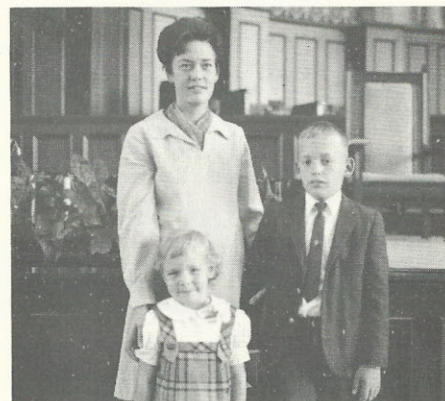
