



Pastor's Paragraphs

"AUGUST 24—SANTO DOMINGO— DOMINICAN REPUBLIC"

Only the good Lord knows how many lives have been touched and changed by OPERATION: GOOD SAMARITAN-SOUTH. From the standpoint of the physical, some 2,000 people have received some sort of treatment from the medical teams. The treatment continues. Two operations are scheduled for today. Dr. Clevenger and his team of young people will be operating at the Baptist Temple. In the very spot where the pastor speaks of Jesus giving sight to the



blind—the blind will be given sight. It's a thrilling thing to witness a cataract operation and see the patient get up and walk home!

There is no way these spiritual results can be calculated. Literally thousands of people have heard our choir sing and our young people testify for Jesus Christ. The President of the Republic, Joaquin Balaguer, expressed his deep appreciation to the Samaritans for their work in the Dominican Republic. A multitude of others have joined the President in expressing their thanks.

Our young people have wept during the past 2 weeks as they have seen the needs of the Dominicans, but more than their emotions have been stirred. They have rolled up their sleeves and touched sick bodies with healing hands. They have touched countless hearts while speaking for Jesus Christ in 3 languages. They have spoken in English and Spanish and in the most convincing language of all—THE LANGUAGE OF LOVE.

The good Lord willing, we will be home by the time you receive this bulletin. I'll look forward to seeing you in God's House Sunday in Pensacola.


The election of deacons will take place at the 11:00 o'clock service on Sunday, September 12, when 11 men will be elected.
