



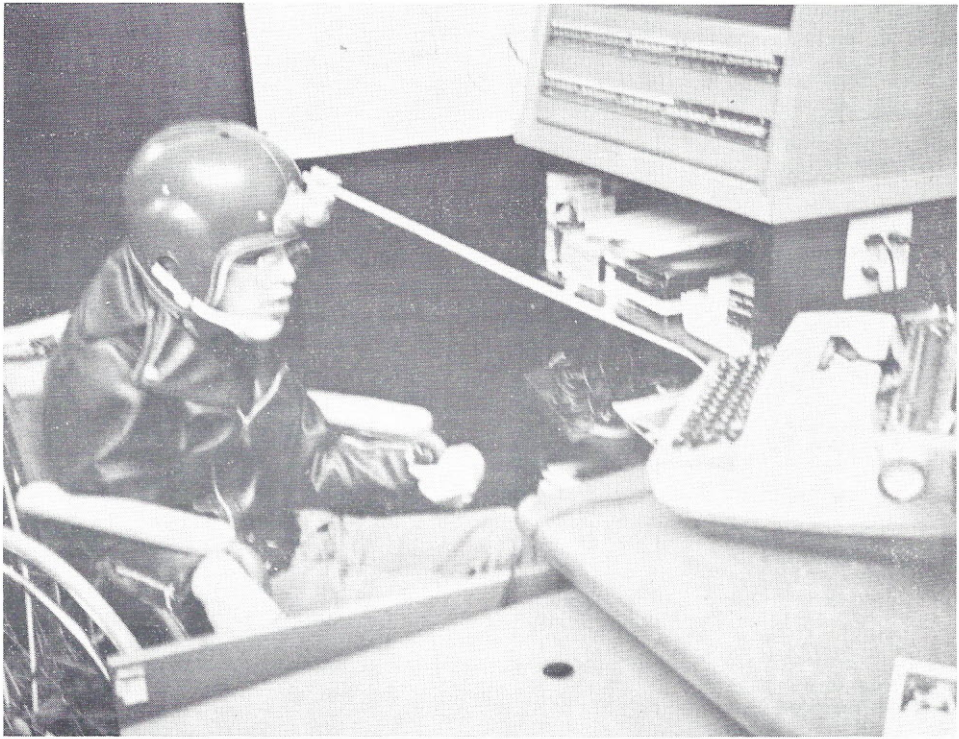

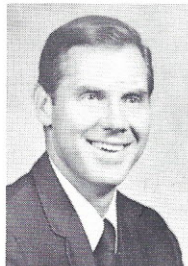

# Pastor's Paragraphs

## "REMEMBER THE LORD IN YOUR WILL"

When I was a student in Southern Seminary, Louisville, Kentucky, the LOUIS-



VILLE TIMES used to always carry the news of the wills most recently probated. The beneficiaries of the wills and the amount of the estate left to each were listed. Whenever a Catholic will was probated, almost always some Catholic church or institution was one of the beneficiaries. No matter how wealthy the

Baptist might have been whose will was being probated, seldom had the church or any of its agencies been remembered in the will. Why? Why didn't the Baptists leave a portion of their estates to the church and cause they loved? Negligence, perhaps. Just never thought of it, probably. It's just not customary to remember the church in their wills. It is not that we do not care. We do care and give generously, even sacrificially while we live.

Our CATHOLIC FRIENDS can teach us a mighty IMPORTANT LESSON at this point. Everyone of us should seriously consider remembering the Lord in our will. Dr. Rollin S. Burhans makes these 4 suggestions:

1. If you have no heirs, leave your estate to the church and/or institution and causes you love.
2. If you have heirs, make the church one of your beneficiaries and let the church share and share alike with them.
3. Or, designate that 10% of your estate after all debts are paid, go to the church.
4. Or, remember the church with some definite amount, saying thereby, "I remember my church with love and I want to make one final gift to help carry on the ministry I loved and supported."

You're a great and gracious people and it's a joy to be your pastor. I'll see you Sunday, the good Lord willing.

## ASSOCIATIONAL MUSIC WORKSHOP

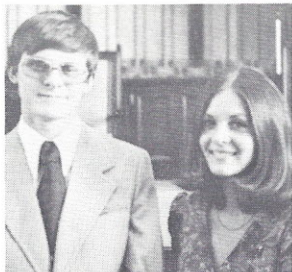
