Pastor's Paragraphs

"THE DIVIDEND"

When you make a wise investment, it pays dividends. Several years ago I bought



some stock in a company. Since then, every six months, without fail, I've received a dividend check. Could you cash this \$90 check for me!

The greatest investment of all is the investment of your life in the cause of Jesus Christ. The dividends are unbelievable.

Long years ago, Paul made such an investment. He invested his life in the cause of Jesus Christ. If you have read closely the letters of this man, you've noticed that on many occasions he speaks of the rich dividends that he has received from the investment.

In the fifth chapter of Galatians, Paul mentions some of these dividends, "The fruit of the spirit is love, joy, peace, long suffering, gentleness, goodness, faith, meekness and temperance . . ." Paul also received unlimited power, "I can do all things through Christ."
