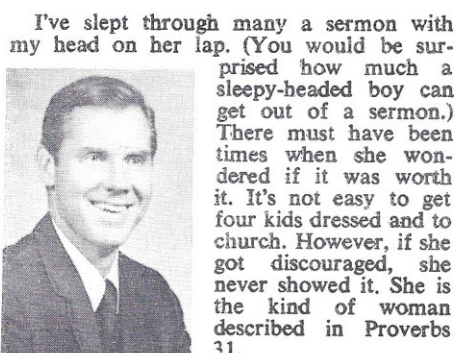
Something of God is in a mother's love,

TRIBUTE TO A SONGBIRD



I've slept through many a sermon with my head on her lap. (You would be surprised how much a sleepy-headed boy can get out of a sermon.) There must have been times when she wondered if it was worth it. It's not easy to get four kids dressed and to church. However, if she got discouraged, she never showed it. She is the kind of woman described in Proverbs 31.
