





## "THE DEMOLITION OF A HOUSE"

Thanks to the intervention of a 22 year old college student, a house designed some 60 years ago by the famous architect, Frank Lloyd Wright, will not be destroyed.



Marta Golicki is working for the Florida Historical Commission this summer. She found the building with the help of local residents in Palm Beach. The building was scheduled for demolition next month. I'm glad they're going to save it. There is something sad about the demolition of a home.

The sad truth is that hundreds of homes are being demolished in America every single day.

Nearly 33% of the marriages in America end in divorce. Ferdinand Lundberg said, "The family is near the point of complete extinction." William Woolf, a psychoanalyst remarks, "The family is dead except for one or possibly two years of child raising. This will be its only function."
