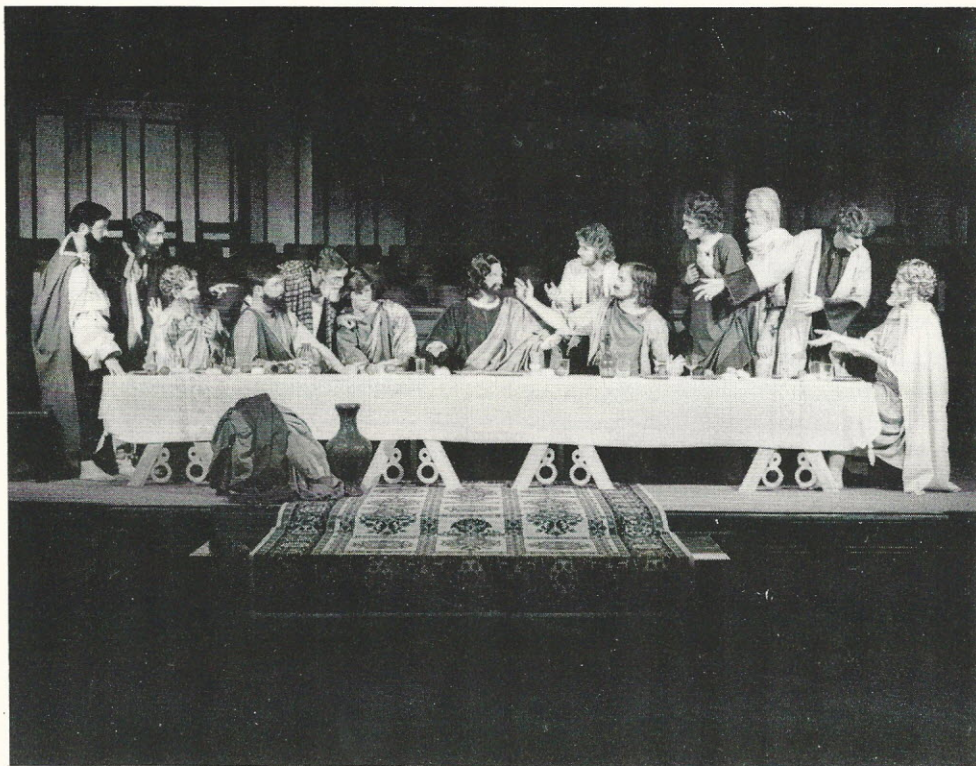

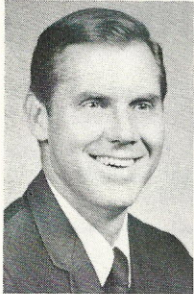

Pastor's Paragraphs

"UNIVERSAL HUNGER"

There has always existed in the heart of man a hunger for immortality.



Some years ago, in Georgia, an amateur archaeologist got permission to open up an Indian mound. In the grave he found the skeleton of a little Indian girl with the bones of her right hand extended. She held in her hand a small clay jar. In the jar were the tiny bones of a bird.

Long before the white man came here with his Bible and the Easter faith, an Indian mother in her grief and her love placed with the body of her child her favorite little pet so that she might play with it in the afterworld of the spirit.
