## *"AND YE CLOTHED ME"*



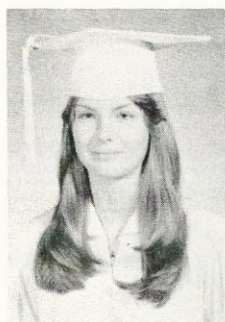
