

The Church Missions Committee and the Woman's Missionary Union are sponsoring a special Fellowship and Bible Study for Vietnamese on Monday evening, October 27, at 7:30 P.M.

Coming to lead the Bible Study for our Vietnamese friends is Pastor Tran Minh Hai, a native Vietnamese. He came to this country in 1970 on a special training mission at Biloxi, Mississippi. While there he was led to Christ by his instructor. Following his return to Vietnam, he was called into the ministry. He served as pastor of the Love Baptist Church in Da Nang while serving in the South Vietnamese Air Force. He is now serving with the First Baptist Church, Ft. Walton Beach as a Mission Pastor.
