Music Notes

HOW TO SING IN CHURCH

The psalmist admonishes us to "serve the Lord with gladness" and to "make a joyful noise unto the Lord" (Psalm 100). The apostle Paul said, "I will sing with the spirit, and I will sing with the understanding."

Never should a Christian be guilty of singing in a meaningless, half-hearted, droning manner. Christianity is a positive religion. It is a religion in major key—joyous, exultant, and victorious!

Dwight Moody said, "Singing does at least as much as preaching to impress the Word of God upon people's minds."

Each singer thus becomes a minister, a proclaimer, a witness of grace, and one to whom is entrusted responsibility for the spread of the gospel. John Wesley was one of the first evangelists to use congregational singing as the effective force it is. He said: "Beware of singing as if you were half dead, or half-asleep; but lift up your voice with strength." But long before Wesley, the psalmist proclaimed, "Sing aloud unto God our strength."

Let us remember that the militant singing of hymns of Luther were more effective than all the swords of Europe.—Copied.
