

# Pastor's Paragraphs

with fear and trembling. There was no reason to fear, the people could not have been lovelier.

The climax of the meeting came on Saturday night. At the close of this service a man and wife in their middle 70's came making their profession of faith in Christ.

Our revival is now at hand. I believe with all of my heart and soul it is going to be a good one. Is your own heart prepared for this meeting?

A famous psychiatrist, Dr. Karl Menninger, said, "The greatest enemy we face today is not atheism nor fanaticism, but apathy. People just don't care." Apathy is the lack of passion, emotion or excitement. Apathy is much like the turtle caught in the middle of a busy intersection. He pulls his head into his shell and lets the world go rushing madly past. But ask any one turtle. That's a good way to get the life smashed out of you. It is dangerous to be apathetic. When you think about Christ — do you get excited about telling the "good news?" At the risk of being hypocritical and unkind, I make this comment. "I believe that our 20th century church has lost the zeal of evangelistic outreach." I shake and shudder inside when I see the atheistic mass standing at my door, and I am afraid to let them in because of what it might cost me — but God says to me — "Let them in and I will be there in the midst of them: have no fear." Let's pray that God's will be accomplished, no matter what the cost.
