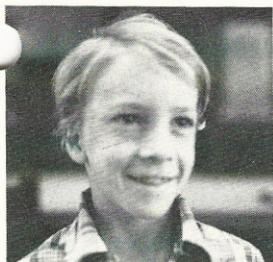
DEACONS OF THE WEEK
