Dr. Brooks is a native North Carolinian, a graduate of Mars Hill College and of Wake Forest College in North Carolina, a graduate of Southern Baptist Theological Seminary with graduate studies at Columbia University and Union Seminary. He served as pastor in North Carolina, Georgia, South Carolina, Louisiana and as Training Union Secretary for North Carolina prior to serving as pastor of this church 1954 to 1958. He went from Pensacola to the presidency of Carver School of Missions and Social Work in Louisville and then to the pastorate of the Highland Baptist Church in Louisville. He served from 1966 to 1976 as Director of the Division of Church Programs, North Carolina Baptist State Convention. During a portion of this time he served as a visiting instructor at Southeastern Baptist Theological Seminary in Wake Forest, North Carolina.

Mrs. Brooks (Ruby) and their oldest daughter, Mary Kelley, will be with him during his days in Pensacola.
