

## *Dr. Sullivan Preaches Sunday*



Our preacher for Sunday is to be Dr. James L. Sullivan, former President of the Southern Baptist Convention and former President of the Sunday School Board of the Southern Baptist Convention.

A native Mississippian, Dr. Sullivan is a graduate of Mississippi College and of Southern Baptist Theological Seminary. He held pastorates in Kentucky, Tennessee, Mississippi and in Abilene, Texas before becoming the President of the Sunday School Board in 1953. He served as President of the Southern Baptist Convention in 1976-1977. Dr. Sullivan is a very popular speaker at Baptist Assemblies and Conventions. He is the author of several books published by our Sunday School Board. Dr. Sullivan has preached in our church before and we look forward to having him here on Sunday.


