


DR. RUSSELL H. DILDAY
President-Elect

Southwestern Baptist Theological Seminary

Dr. Russell H. Dilday, Jr. has been elected as 6th President of Southwestern Seminary. He will begin his official duties as President on August 1, but prior to that time he is working closely with Dr. Robert E. Naylor, whom he will succeed on August 1.

Dr. Dilday is a native of Amarillo, Texas. He is a graduate of Baylor University and of Southwestern Baptist Theological Seminary. Prior to his election as President of Southwestern, he was pastor of Second Ponce de Leon Baptist Church, Atlanta, Georgia.

Dr. Pruden is a native of Chase City, Virginia, a graduate of the University of Richmond and of Southern Baptist Theological Seminary. He did graduate studies at the Yale Divinity School and received his PhD degree at the University of Edinburgh, Scotland. He served pastorates in Petersburg, Virginia and for 32 years was pastor of the First Baptist Church, Washington, D.C. He served as President of the American Baptist Convention and served as a member of the Executive Committee of the Baptist World Alliance for more than 20 years. Now in semi-retirement, he lives in Raleigh, N.C. where he is pastor in residence at Meredith College, guest professor at the Southeastern Baptist Theological Seminary, and Chaplain of the North Carolina State Senate.
