FOR SUNDAY**



Dr. Roy L. Honeycutt, Dean of the School of Theology, Southern Baptist Theological Seminary, Louisville, Kentucky, will be our preacher for both services Sunday.

Dr. Honeycutt, a native of Mississippi, is a graduate of Mississippi College and earned his Ph.D. from Southern Seminary in 1958. He has served as a pastor in Mississippi and Kentucky, but most of his career has been as a teacher. He has served as Instructor and Professor of Old Testament, and Academic Dean at Midwestern Baptist Theological Seminary. In 1975 he joined the faculty of Southern Seminary as Provost, Professor of Old Testament and Dean of Theology. Dr. Honeycutt has written in depth articles on Exodus, II Kings and Hosea for the Broadman Bible Commentary, five independent books on Old Testament related subjects, and has contributed numerous articles to books, journals and other publications. We look forward to hearing him Sunday morning at 11:00 and Sunday night at 7:15.
