August is here! Can you believe it. How fast the summer has slipped by, and what a fantastic summer it has been. No slump this summer at First Baptist, but a summer surge as we prepare for our finest fall.

AN ABUNDANT AUGUST . . . is a great way to end the summer and begin the fall. I hope you will be here every Sunday morning for my special series on the family. The average age of those who come is low to middle twenties, and the average stay is three to four months. 
