Several have asked about the final sermon in the series on "Great Mountain Peaks of the Bible." In this sermon on the Consum-



mation of the Church, I dealt with the different ways of understanding the end of the world. I am going to print this sermon, so it will be available in a few weeks. I feel very gratified in what we were able to accomplish in this series of sermons

and hope that these twenty-one sermons enabled you to come to a better understanding of the overall picture of God's redemptive history.

JANUARY IS OVER . . . and we have been reminded again of what a great financial challenge we have undertaken this year. Our receipts are considerably under the budget requirement for the first month of 1983. We have not yet experienced what we must have — a broader base of giving to the life of the church. Will you please pray about your part in the undergirding of our 1983 ministry? And begin this next Sunday to give, regularly, generously, and faithfully to the work of God. We need a strong financial base for our ministries in 1983.

WE HAVE ALSO COMPLETED . . . the first thirty days of our 120 Days of Praise. I am so thankful for the commitments to prayer that you made. I have never had so many interferences arise to keep me from prayer. Nevertheless, I have never experienced the joy in my own prayer life that I have this last 30 days. Let's continue to pray 20 minutes a day for the life of our church. I believe God will bless us for it.

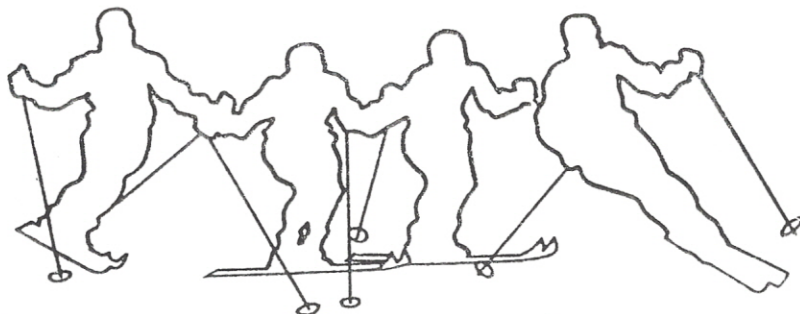
to grow in a great church here in the heart of Pensacola.

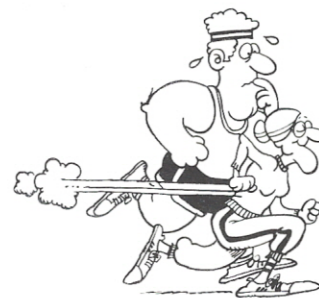

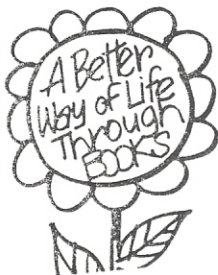

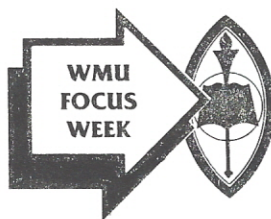
