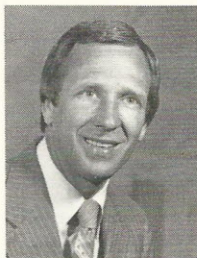

YOU REALLY OUTDID YOURSELF . . .

financially as we closed out 1984. When the final gifts were tabulated, you gave \$1,429,466 to the 1984 budget. That was \$52,466 over our budget of \$1,377,000. Thank you for your generosity. Our challenge for 1985 is even bigger. So we must continue in the spirit of giving which we have demonstrated these last few months.

LOTTIE MOON . . . still needs to be considered in your January giving. Many of you have already taken care of this, but we are still short of our goal of \$76,000. As of Sunday, our gifts to the Lottie Moon Foreign Mission offering total \$47,709. Before January is over with, let's top our goal.

How long has it been since you have done an in-depth study of this longest and richest book in the Bible? I hope you will join us as we study this book together beginning this Sunday night. 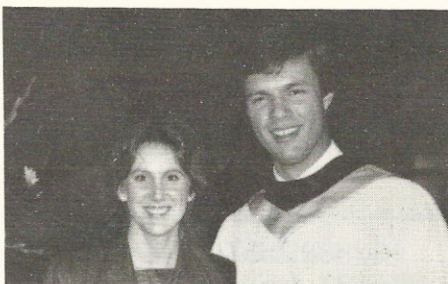
