

DR. JAMES PLEITZ


Preacher for our Revival is Dr. James Pleitz, Pastor of Park Cities Baptist Church of Dallas, Texas.

Long-time members of our church know Dr. Pleitz well, but for members joining during the past seven years here is a brief statement of introduction.

Dr. Pleitz has had a distinguished record of service to the denomination all during his years of pastoral duties.

He served many Florida Baptist committees and President of Florida Baptist Convention while he was pastor in Pensacola.

Dr. Pleitz was President of the Southern Baptist Pastor's Conference (1974-75) and Chairman of the SBC Executive Committee 1968-69 and served on many other convention agencies and committees.


