The Music Program has been outstanding this month. The High School Choir is working on a musical to be presented in June and we are looking forward to that.


THE SOUTHERN BAPTIST CONVENTION . . . has been going

MISSION UPDATE

Our FBC missionary team, *David and Melissa Chism* and *Frank and Bernice Osborne*, will leave June 24 for Ecuador. There are some things that we, as a congregation, will want to begin doing in support of this evangelistic outreach. First, we need to be praying for all the missionaries who will be going and particularly those from our church. Here are just some of the things we need to cover with prayer now — pray for their safety in travel, for families that will be left at home, for health, communication skills (not much English is spoken in Ecuador), for the missionaries who are in Ecuador getting ready for this crusade and the churches our people will be going to, and, most of all, pray that many decisions will be made for Jesus.

You were very generous in your giving for Bibles for the Japan and the Korean missions and you will want to have a part in sending God's Word to Ecuador. This can be done through the office.

Sharon Thompson will work in Tennessee this summer as Assistant Acteen Camp Director. You will want to support Sharon with your prayers and give her a word of encouragement.

Steve Findley is the answer to prayers of many of our people who have prayed long and hard for God to call out one of our young people for full-time mission work. Steve, a graduate of the University of Alabama, will go to Richmond for five and a half weeks of training and come back to Pensacola briefly before going to Singapore as a Journeyman for two years. We prayed for Steve as he went to Israel last year and when he returned he spoke of that prayer power in his life and what he was able to do because of it. It's time to pray for Steve again!
