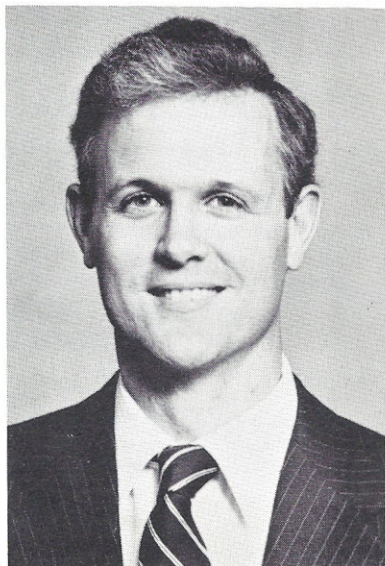

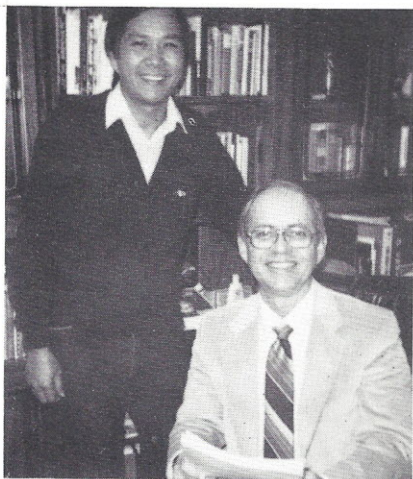

Rev. Hong Dang to Enter Seminary

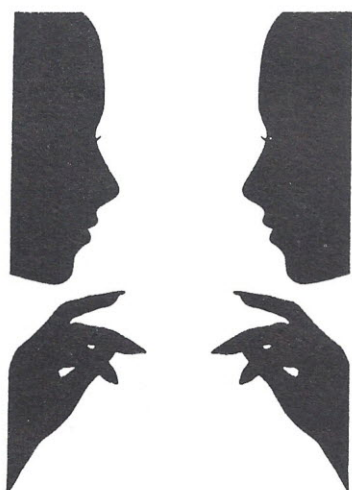
Rev. Hong Dang, who holds a part-time position on our church staff as Minister to Internationals, will become a student at the New Orleans Theological Seminary on January 16.

Hong began his seminary training in his native country of Viet Nam and has continued to work and pray toward the day when he could resume his theological education since coming to Pensacola ten years ago following the fall of his country to the Communists.

Rev. Dang will continue to work with our church on Saturday, Sunday, and Monday of each week (Seminary classes are Tuesday through Friday), and his family will continue live in Pensacola.

At the recommendation of our Missions Committee, the 1986 Budget of our church provides the financial support needed to cover the actual expenses of Hong at the Seminary.

For the past several years, the Missions Committee of the church has encouraged Hong to take this important step, and finally all of the praying and planning have culminated so that Hong's ten-year dream will come true — completion of his seminary training.

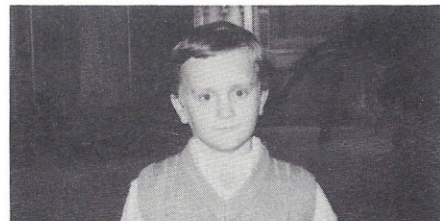
