The Seagle Say:

179 PEOPLE OUT VISITING . . .

is an unbelievable, wonderful, fantastic thing! The results? Only eternity will fully declare it. Here's what we do know:

... *lonely* people were told "I love you. We care about you."

... *records* were corrected. Many folk had moved. In several cases the new home owners were invited to join the journey with the family of First Baptist Church. ... those *without Christ* were told "God loves you and has a wonderful plan for your life!"

Over and over and over we heard the affirmation of a caring people putting their arms around a city and saying — "In Jesus' name, we care!"

IT GOES . . .

without saying, but I'll say it anyway! We are not alone in our concern for the City. Olive and East Brent and Myrtle Grove and Hillcrest and Heights and East Hill and . . . others, many others are about the Master's business.

SOME FACTS . . .

need clear understanding. With 150,000 to 180,000 unchurched and unsaved folk around us — well — the task is too big for any one of us, or for that matter, all of us.

MEANWHILE . . .

there's a specific, monumental task before the First Family. A minimum of 1,500 (actually closer to 1,800) people need to be visited — absentees, prospects and church members. Let's do some simple math.

— divide 1500 by 3 = 500.

(3 cards per team.)

— divide 500 by 2 = 250.

(2 member-teams.)

That means we need at least 500 First Family members out saying, "We care."

OUR TENDENCY . . .



The tendency is to look around and see who *is not* visiting instead of who *is*. I have a terrific suggestion — join *me* and let's go visiting. When we do, *both* of us will be so busy *doing* we won't have time to check on anyone else!

What excitement. We'll see the 1400 mark passed soon. Let's do it!
