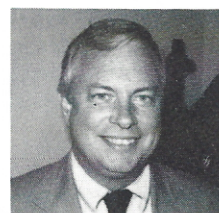

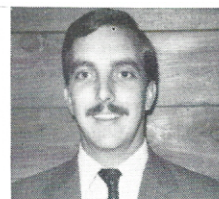

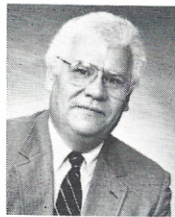

JESUS . . .

was a nickel and nose man. How we use what He gives is called *stewardship*.

How we touch those without Christ is called *evangelism*. Both are priority in the heart of Christ and the plan of God.

I URGE YOU . . .

to join me in emulating the original pattern of "nickels and noses!"

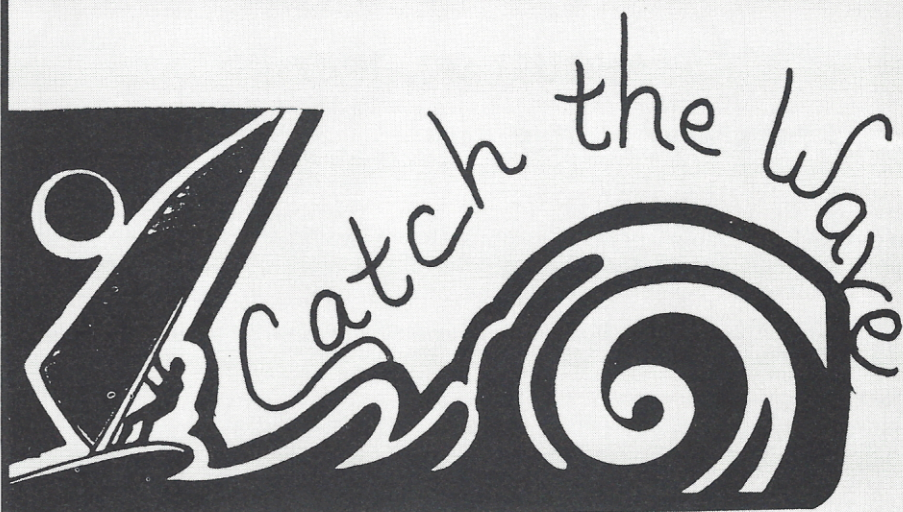
