





## THE SEAGLE SAY:



### Acts...

is an interesting, stimulating, confrontational book. As Paul Harvey would say--Luke tells "the rest of the story!" It's a story of:

- \* Holy Spirit power;
- \* Dynamic advance;
- \* Changed lives;
- \* Super-charged preaching and supernatural living;
- \* Failure and forgiveness;
- \* Martyrdom and amazing grace. I am challenged by Acts as by no other book.

### Specifically...

I am challenged by the blue-print for reaching a hostile religious world as well as a hostile pagan world.

The intriguing idea found in the opening sentences has to do with sharing Christ because we care about people. Let's look at a most interesting idea. Reaching a lost community does not have to do with a program of evangelism. To be sure you understand me--

reaching that costs me nothing but an evening of visitation--6:00 - 8:15 P.M. is not a New Testament pattern. We have not been called to an evening of "duty." We have been called to a life of sharing--daily, personally, lovingly sharing what God has done and is now doing in our lives through Jesus Christ.

### A Program...

of training in evangelism is essential. We must study, pray and learn to effectively share Who Christ is and what He's done. If that program never motivates us to "go be," "go do," "go tell"--well, you guessed it, it's a failure at best.

People come to Christ, come to church, come to Sunday School because we are convinced of His worth and His power and His forgiving love. There's life in Him. We dare not point people to anyone else. It would be much better if the life we have in Christ could be so contagious that all who know us would be infected by Him.

The book of Acts is a contagious book. Let it splash over you and provide life.

I'll see you 1500 strong Sunday.
